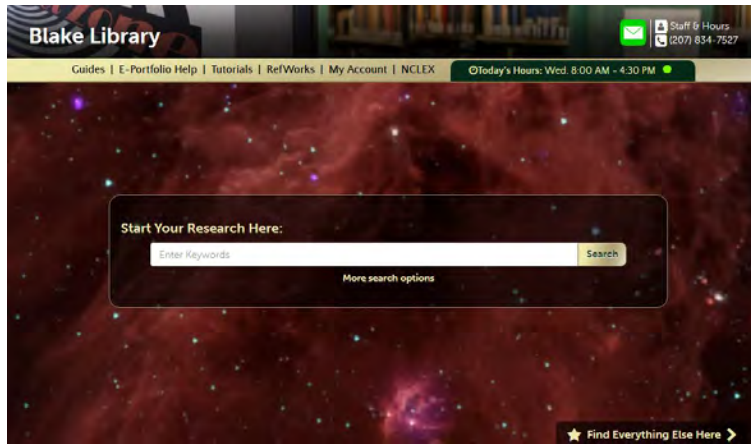
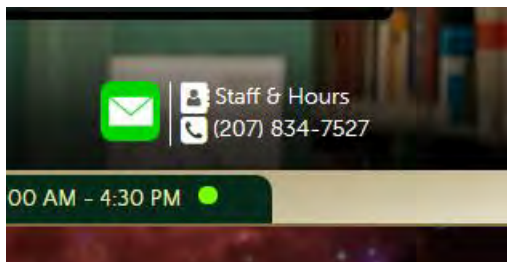


Welcome to Blake Library's tutorial on how to contact library staff.
