Finally, the Status column tells you if the item is available.

Imagine you were looking for a particular brand of potato chip.





You might first call or search the internet to see what store has the brand.



This is the same as searching the online catalog to find out what library has the book.

Then, when you get to the store, you find out what area of the store the chips are in.



This is the same as finding out where the Stacks are, or the Reference area, or the Video section.

When you get to that section or aisle, you then have to look to see where the brand name is in the aisle.



This is the same as finding the QL's or the first part of the call number.

Finally, now that you found the brand, you narrow down to the type of chip; in this case, Potato Chips.



This is the same as using the rest of the call number to get to the exact book.




