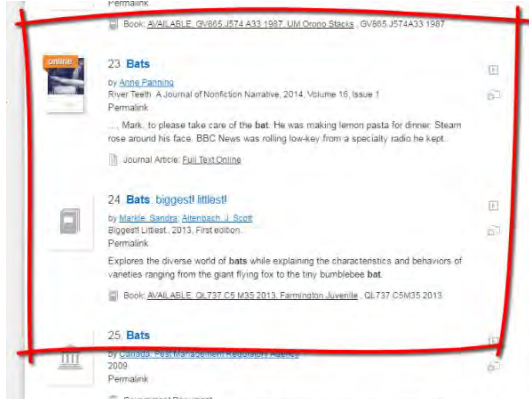


Welcome to a quick look at the Anatomy of a Record

To understand what these results mean without having to click into each, you can get a lot of information right there in your list



When you create a search in OneSearch, you will get a list of results down the middle of the screen.



When you look at a record, you will find a title, author, publication date, sometimes a brief description,



the format of the item (such as ebook, book, video, journal article, etc.),
