

Welcome to a quick tutorial on other options in OneSearch.



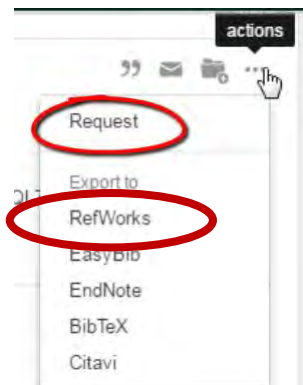
Along the top of the result area there are symbols that allow you to ...



...cite, email, save, and go to More Actions.



Under More Actions you can request books and export citations in various formats and to various citing tools such as RefWorks, which our campus uses.



If you want to see more of the result, you can click on the Preview link to expand the result.



To request an item such as a book or video, you click on the title or More Actions-Request, which will take you to the actual online catalog.



There, you will click on the request link at the top.



You will be prompted for your last name and barcode, and then choose UM Fort Kent as your pick up location.

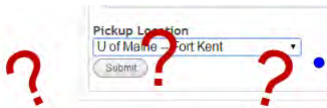
Please enter the following information from your student ID or library card:
